LIVING IN A TROUBLED HOME, Maria^{*} found herself at HGS at the age of 12. Now, two years later we asked if she would share

a bit of her story.

"I have been here at Home of the Good Shepherd for over 2 years. Before coming here I always thought that my life was normal. But my mom was drinking a lot and was not able to look after me anymore and so I was brought to the Home.

Before I arrived I was nervous and scared because I thought that everyone would hate me and that I wouldn't have any friends. It wasn't easy at first being away from my family, but as time went by I recognized that it was good for me that I came here because I was able to learn a lot. I didn't really know anything about the Bible and didn't understand much about it, but here I learned the truth about Jesus.

My older brother and his family live about two hours away and I have started visiting him about once every two months. It is possible that I will have an opportunity to go and live with him at the end of the year but I will have to wait and see what the judge decides. It makes me feel torn between being with family who I barely know, and staving here where I feel cared for. If I go and live with him I know it will be a challenge to stay strong in my walk with the Lord.

I never really thought about my future, but now I'm thinking about it more and more and I would like to be a teacher one day!

What I like most about living here at the Home is that I feel like we are really loved. I have received more love and care here than I did from my own mom. I hope to share Jesus with my family."
